## What does my Monthly Assessment include?

- Cable television & broadband internet package (service and hardware included)
- Community pool upkeep including: cleaning, repair, & maintenance
- Landscaping services including: turf cutting, weed eating, and irrigation maintenance of all yards
- Irrigation water: services include all yards & common areas
- Debris removal of all common areas
- Fence and gate maintenance caused by general wear and tear (damage will assess repair costs from owner and/or tenant).
- Bi-annual fertilization and weed control
- Property and General Liability Insurance for all common areas: Individual Townhome/Single Family Home Insurance is NOT COVERED by the association. Each owner needs to provide a copy of home insurance to the HOA office within 30 days of purchase. \*\*Please note: All insurance policies should reflect townhome or single family home coverage; condominium insurance is NOT accepted.\*\*
